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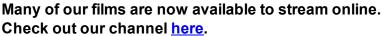

Glendon Collaborating in a Study with Anger Managements Specialists of Santa Barbara

Glendon is assisting Anger Management Specialists of Santa Barbara, who are currently compiling data and in their domestic violence groups between Santa Barbara and Lompoc. The goal for the anger management groups is to create and support an alternative trajectory away from the behaviors that lead back to criminality and thus reduce recidivism. Glendon is developing a computerized scoring program for the FAVT (Firestone Assessment of Violent Thoughts) to aid in data collection and analysis.
